Bassist Luther Hughes received his training at the University of Cincinnati's College Conservatory of Music and Long Beach City College, earning his bachelor's degree from Cal State Long Beach. His teachers included Alex Cirin, Thomas Martin, Nat Gangursky, Eileen Strang and Sue Raney.

Mr. Hughes is involved in the music business in a number of ways:

- As a musician, he currently leads The Cannonball-Coltrane Project, tours occasionally with Nancy Wilson and performs regularly in and around L.A. Over the past 35 plus years he has performed or recorded with jazz legends such as Gene Harris, Mundell Lowe, Joe Henderson, Carmen MacRae, Willie Bobo, Horace Silver, Harold Land, Don Ellis, Joe Pass, Louis Bellson, Hampton Hawes and many more.
- As a record producer and music publisher, Hughes heads up Primrose Lane Music, which he founded in 2004.
- As an educator, Hughes has formerly taught at Cal State University Long Beach, Golden West College and the Musicians Institute. He currently teaches at Saddleback College as well as Cal State Fullerton and also serves as the Southern California Regional Director for Bruce Forman's JazzMasters Workshop.
